For schoolwide Second Step® Elementary implementation, use the recommended process with its six main task categories: Motivate, Prepare, Train, Support, Validate, and Sustain. Each task category is made up of a set of recommended tasks. Choose the tasks from each task category that meet your current implementation level. Monitor and adjust your implementation plan regularly to meet your needs, since they may change from year to year.

Evaluating Implementation



The implementation of Second Step at your school:

- How many students are receiving Second Step lessons?
- How many of the lessons are being taught?
- How closely are lessons being taught to how they are written?
- Are students doing Daily Practice Activities?
- What else is being done outside formal lessons to reinforce Second Step skills, both in the classroom and throughout the school?

HOW do we evaluate implementation?



Collect data on the intervention students are receiving:

- Implementation Survey
- Lesson Completion Checklist
- Lesson Delivery and Reinforcement Checklist



Implementation Fidelity

The extent to which the program is taught as written.

- Teaching every part of each lesson
- Teaching every lesson
- Teaching lessons in order
- Preserving content of lessons

Understanding the level of implementation fidelity helps us to understand why certain outcomes are evident.


Using School Data for Evaluating Outcomes

Ongoing support for the program by building leaders has been shown to be the number one factor that drives continued successful implementation over time.








Behaviour Referral Data Examples


CLASSROOM REFERRALS
