Q: *What are we evaluating?*

A: Second Step Implementation and Second Step Outcomes.

Q: *How do we evaluate our Second Step implementation?*

A: Compare the actual Second Step implementation at your school with the ideal implementation as prescribed in the program.

Q: *What is Implementation Fidelity for Second Step?*

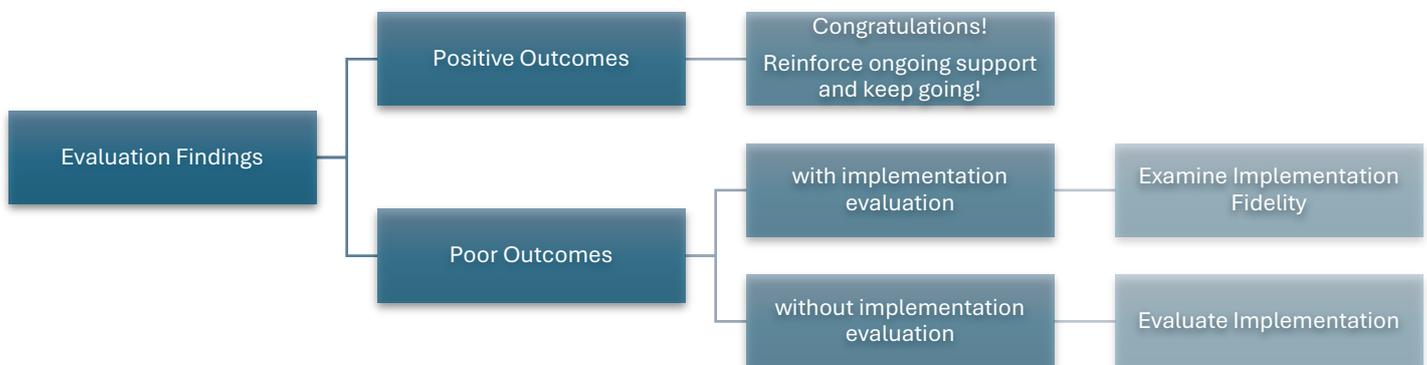

- Teaching every part of each lesson
 - Teaching every lesson
 - Teaching lessons in order
 - Preserving content of lessons
 - Reinforcing skills and concepts daily

Q: *How do we evaluate outcomes of our Second Step implementation?*

A: The easiest way to do this is to use existing school data – we recommend using behaviour referral data as this is more directly linked to Second Step implementation than attendance, grades or test scores.

Q: What resources are available to help us evaluate program outcomes?

A: - Formative assessments for students include:

- Lesson reflection prompts found under “Day 5” in the Daily Practice section of the Following Through Cards
- Home Links
- Brain Builder observational assessments (For Kindergarten to Year 3)
- Weekly Skill Check (for Grades 2 and 3 only)
- Summative assessments for each year-level can be used to determine how well students have acquired knowledge about the skills, behaviours, and attitudes taught in the program.
